Growing Together Garden – Seasonal Upkeep	Seasonal upkeep: Assist with needs including planting, weeding, clean up, and mowing.	
Farmer’s Market Sales	Farmer’s Market sales: Gather produce from garden to transfer to site, set up/take down, sell the harvested produce. Need 1-2 volunteers per Saturday from 7:30 am to 1:30 pm. (Season = approx. 21 weeks)	
Hose team (FULL)	Assist with setting up, maintaining and putting away the hoses in the Community Garden.	Anita, Julia
Mowing team	Assist with regular mowing the Community Garden’s and GTG paths and fence lines.	Kathy
Equipment Maintenance team	Provide or oversee repairs on equipment such as lawn mowers, chippers, and carts.	
Weed trimming team	Assist with weed trimming fence lines, corners of plots, corners of hoses, compost area as well as helping other gardeners with weeding issues	
Compost team	Assist with monitoring Gorilla Carts, manage compost stations, remove garden debris.	Emily
Flower team	Assist with tending the flower beds, the native bed next to the gate, the medicinal bed by the hoop house, and the perennial bed at the end of the Fence Line Plot.	Kathy
